NWBCCC Member Spot Light(Bill Puskas)



I'm Bill Puskas. I joined NWBC car club three years ago after my wife, Melanie, and I moved to Northern Idaho.

My car is a 1971 Jaguar E-type Series II.

I became interested in Jags while I was in college. My best friend paid for school by buying and repairing British cars and then reselling them. The one car he owned that really caught my eye was a 1962 Series I E-type. After he repaired that car, he chose to drive it for about a year. I enjoyed road trips in the Jag and decided I wanted to own one.

I purchased my Jaguar in February 1975 from the original owner for \$3,600 after graduating college with a degree in accounting. The owner had not listed the car for sale but his wife "surprised" him by purchasing a new Cadillac and needed room in the garage. Unbeknownst to him, she listed the Jag for sale.

The Jag's Blue Book value was about \$6,000 at the time but the buyout on the bank note was only \$3,600 and she wanted the car gone that weekend! He was a divorce attorney and, although not happy he was losing his Jaguar, told me it was far cheaper to sell the car at that price than to split his assets.... yet again! He said he was going to buy the newer Series III with a V-12 the following year.

I remember my father thought the Jaguar was a foolish purchase since I had just graduated college and started a new job. He figured I'd only keep it for a year or two and didn't know how long my new job would last.

Actually, that job I started right out of college, is the job I retired from 40 years later as a CPA and partner with Moss Adams LLP....and the one- or two-year ownership of the Jag is coming up on 50 years.

Since I've owned it, I had the engine and transmission rebuilt, had it painted when the silver paint began to fade and had the leather seats redone. I was previously a member of JCNA (Jaguar Club of North America) but find our British Car club to be much more friendly and inviting. I especially enjoy our drives, the annual BritBull car show and value the friendships of fellow British car owners.
