President's Note

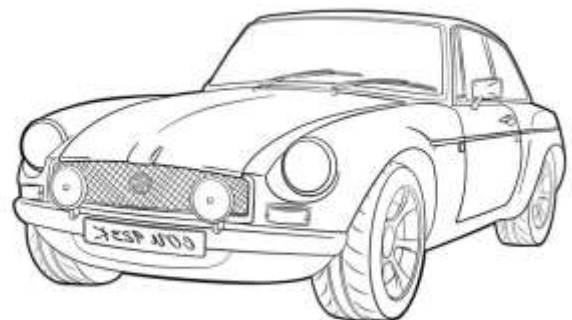
