PROCEDURES FOR REGISTERING CARS AT BRITBULL

- A car drives in greeted by the photographer.
- Photographer gives the driver a card with a car# on it.
- Driver stands beside car for picture.
- Driver parks car as directed.
- Driver takes card with car # to the registration desk.
- The registrar takes the driver's name and pulls the driver's alphabetized windscreen card that Kevin has brought with him.
- The registrar writes the car # on the windscreen card which is given to the driver who will place it on the car windscreen.
- The registrar gives the driver a ballot which must be turned in to the registrar by noon. The registrar will give the completed ballots to Kevin.

PROCEDURE FOR DRIVERS WHO HAVE NOT PRE-REGISTERED

- After parking, the driver gives the registrar the card from the photographer with the # on it.

- The driver fills out a registration form and pays registration and shirt costs if any.
- The driver fills out a windscreen card with the # from the photographer and puts it on the car.
